Yale, Harvard and UC Berkeley law schools withdraw from US News

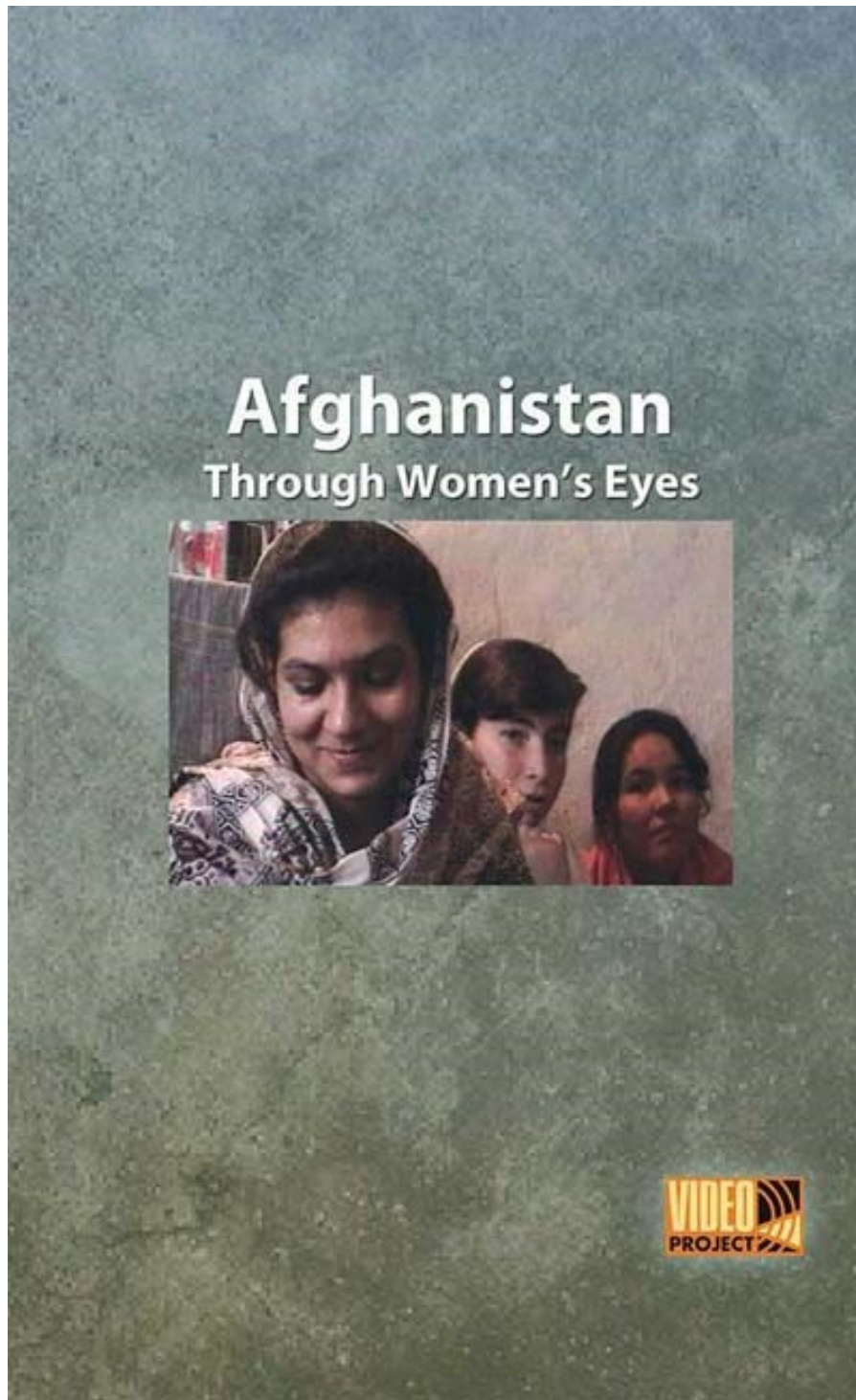

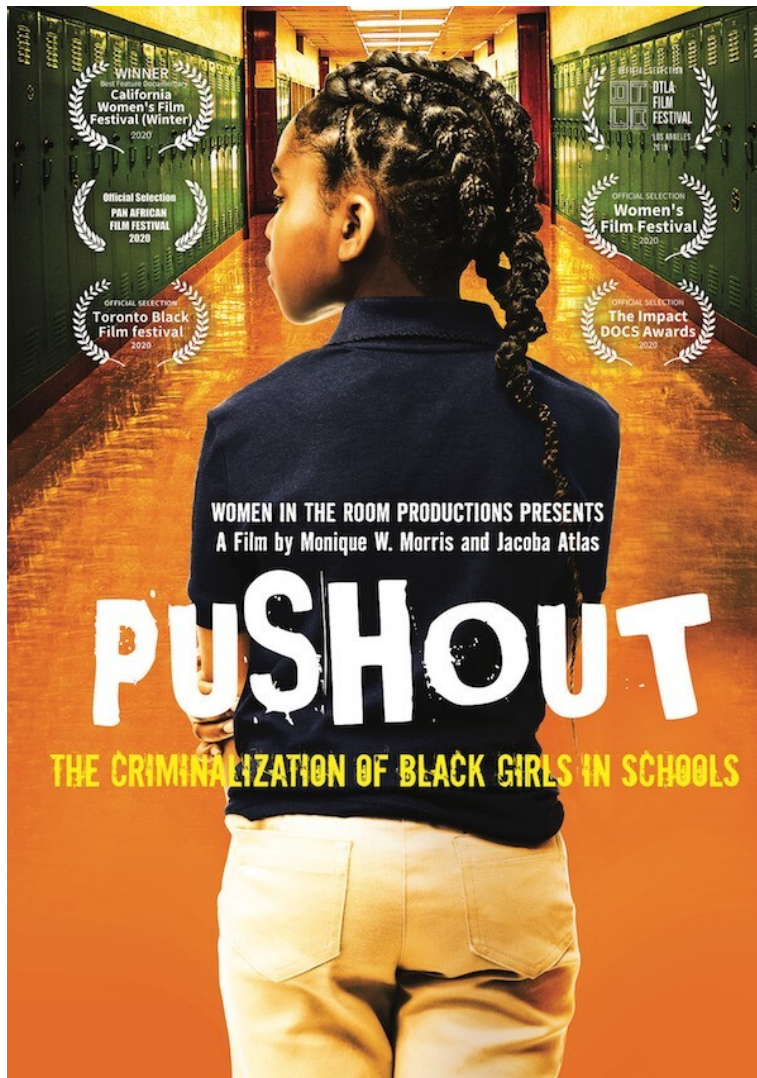

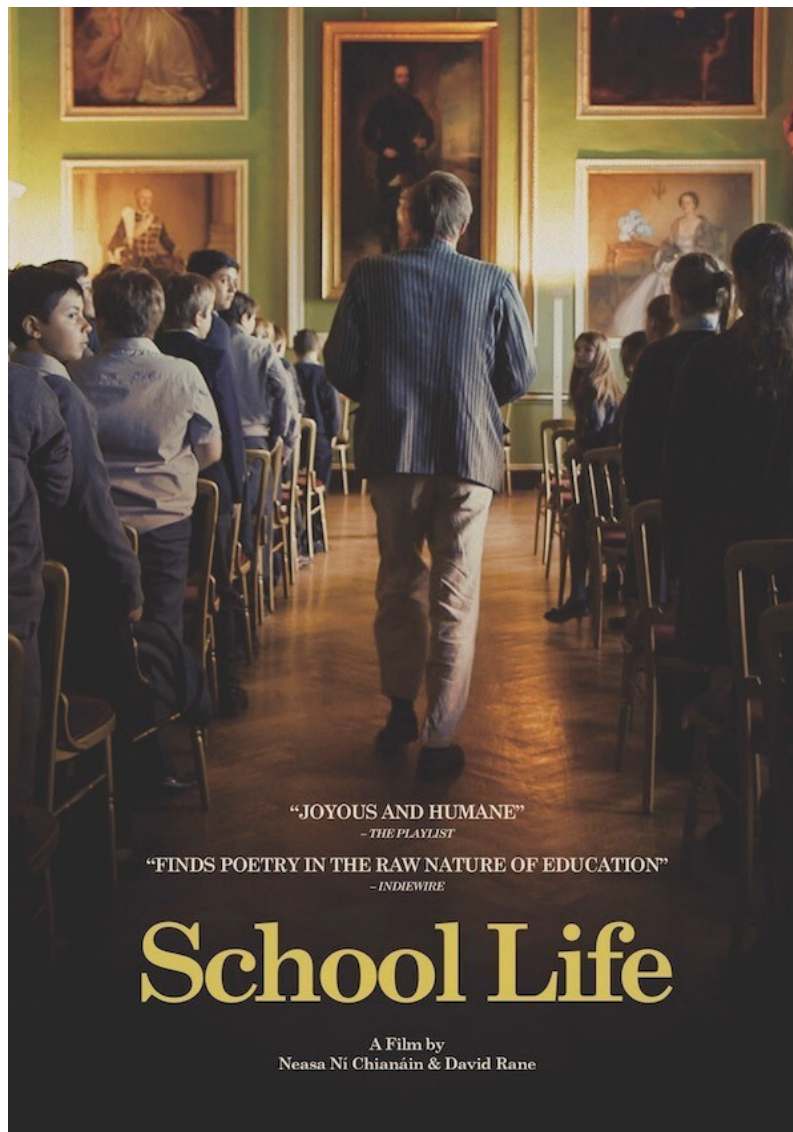
How recruiters in India use false promises to lure students to Canada
